## *National Meet Planning Update For a 2018 National Event*

We tried to get together in August to visit a potential host hotel, **The Sea Crest in Falmouth**, unfortunately the timing did not work out for everyone.

My Father Richard Reinbold and I did some research on the hotel, we do not see how we can hold a national show at the hotel. We are looking into a couple of areas near the hotel for use as show field. Danielle from the Sea Crest is putting together a proposal to see what is needed for a financial commitment from the club.

There is some concern we do not have the ability to do a national meet, with good reason. I think one of the deciding factors will be the financial commitment the club needs to provide the hotel.

At our last meeting we discussed instead of hosting a national event, we should look into a regional meet. John Trotter did some research into a host hotel in the Sturbridge area.

The hotel has the ability to host the show there but the financial commitment is not in reach for the club. John inquired with an estimate of 100 potential rooms. They require us to pay up front 25% of the room rentals, 25% of the rent of the banquet hall and 25% of the parking lot rental fee plus a credit card on file for these charges.

I will update everyone on the information Danielle sends me. We will have to make a decision soon if we are going to move forward for a national show. *Doug Reinbold*

The Little Red School House Car Show is organized as an old fashioned low key car meet like the early Dusters Meet which was held for the first time in 1939. We will hold a 50/50 raffle to benefit

We will have an optional foliage tour of about 15 miles through some of the scenic back roads of Dunstable, Tyngsboro and Westford for those who are interested. This event, held on Saturday the week after Hershey is designed to help us get over the fact that end of the old car season is fast approaching and maybe it's time to put the old cars and trucks away for the winter. On the bright side it's a great time to be in New England and the foliage is near its at peak.
